Chief and Council hereby provides notice of the upcoming election for two vacancies on the Seabird Island Education Committee. The positions are for a term of two years. The Education Committee presently meets every third Friday of each month beginning at 9:00AM.

Key Criteria for All Candidates

- Broad experience, with an understanding of the complexities of the Education program.
- Candidate must be a Member of Seabird Island Band.
- Must be a resident within Stó:lô territory.
- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Pass a criminal record check.

An Effective Candidate Should

- Be familiar with the issues in First Nations education.
- Know, understand and believe in the goals and objectives of the Education program.
- Be willing to attend committee member training workshops and planning sessions.
- Be willing to attend monthly meetings.
- Promote language and culture.

All interested Band Members are encouraged to submit a letter of interest with two letters of support from Band Members. The letters should speak to any relevant experience, the reasons why you would be a good Education Committee member, and your availability/commitment to attend one Friday meeting per month.

Candidates are encouraged to request a copy of the **Education Governance Manual** to review. The Education Committee Election will take place on **Wednesday, October 14th, 2020**. Details of the election process will be posted on the Seabird Island website.
