



APPLYING AS AN ESTATE REPRESENTATIVE

A deceased Claimant is eligible for compensation if he/she attended a school on Schedule K and passed away on or after July 31, 2007.

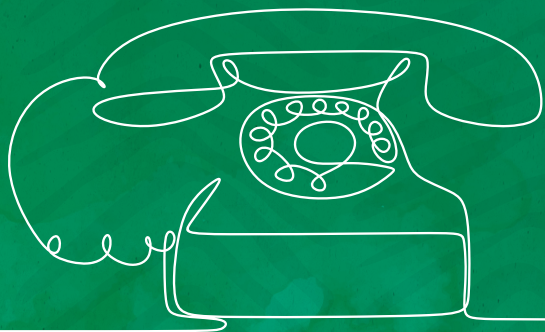

An authorized representative of an eligible deceased Claimant may submit a Claim on behalf of the estate. The representative must be an Executor or Administrator.



Please note that the local Public Trustee Office may already be administering the deceased's estate. You may wish to contact them before taking further steps.



If there is a Will then there may be an appointed Executor. When submitting the Claim Form, the Executor must include a copy of the Will and Death Certificate.



If there is no Will, then different estate rules apply depending on where the deceased ordinarily lived.

OR
OFF-RESERVE?**

If the deceased had no Will and lived **on reserve** (not subject to modern treaty) please contact CIRNAC for information on how to be appointed as the "Administrator" of the estate.

If the deceased had no Will and lived **off-reserve** or in a First Nation community with a modern treaty, then a representative must be appointed by the provincial/territorial court, or if in Quebec, the appointment of a liquidator by the heirs.
