



ELIGIBLE GUARANTORS

Some **Claimants** will not have all the required records for the Claim Form. If you are missing one or more of the required documents, you must submit a **Sworn Declaration**, signed by an **eligible Guarantor**.

Who can sign my Claim Form as an eligible Guarantor?
