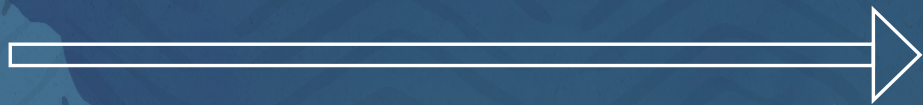




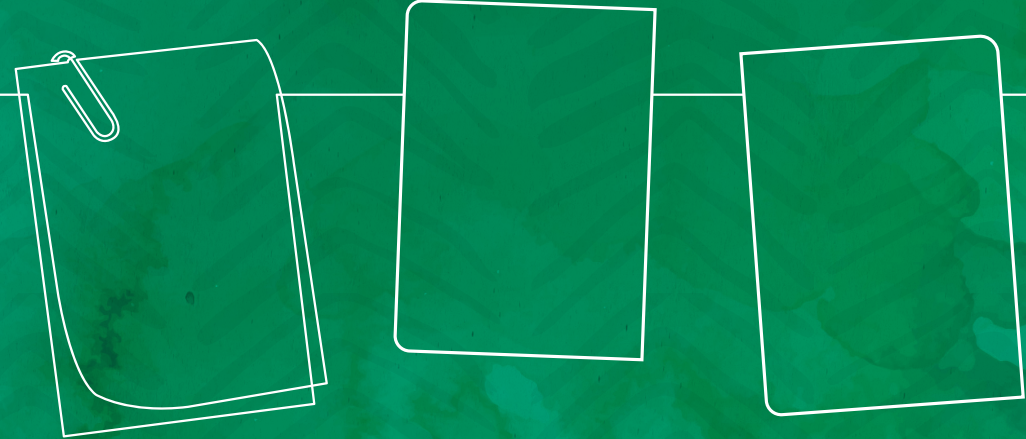
APPLYING AS A REPRESENTATIVE OF A CLAIMANT

A deceased Claimant is eligible for compensation if he/she attended a school on Schedule K and passed away on or after July 31, 2007.

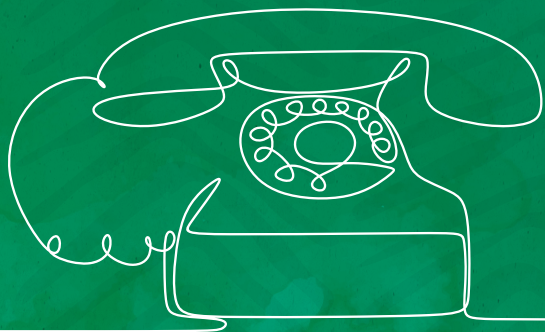

An authorized representative of an eligible deceased Claimant may submit a Claim on behalf of the estate. The representative must be an Executor or Administrator.



Please note that the local Public Trustee Office may already be administering the deceased's estate. You may wish to contact them before taking further steps.



If there is a Will then there may be an appointed Executor. When submitting the Claim Form, the Executor must include a copy of the Will and Death Certificate.



If there is no Will, then different estate rules apply depending on where the deceased ordinarily lived.

If the deceased Claimant had no Will and lived **on reserve** please contact CIRNAC for information on how to be appointed as the "Administrator" of the estate.
