

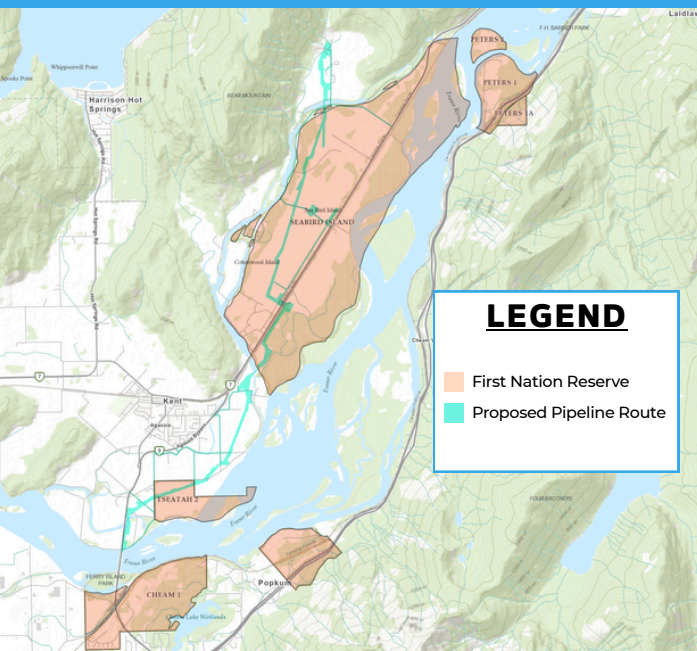
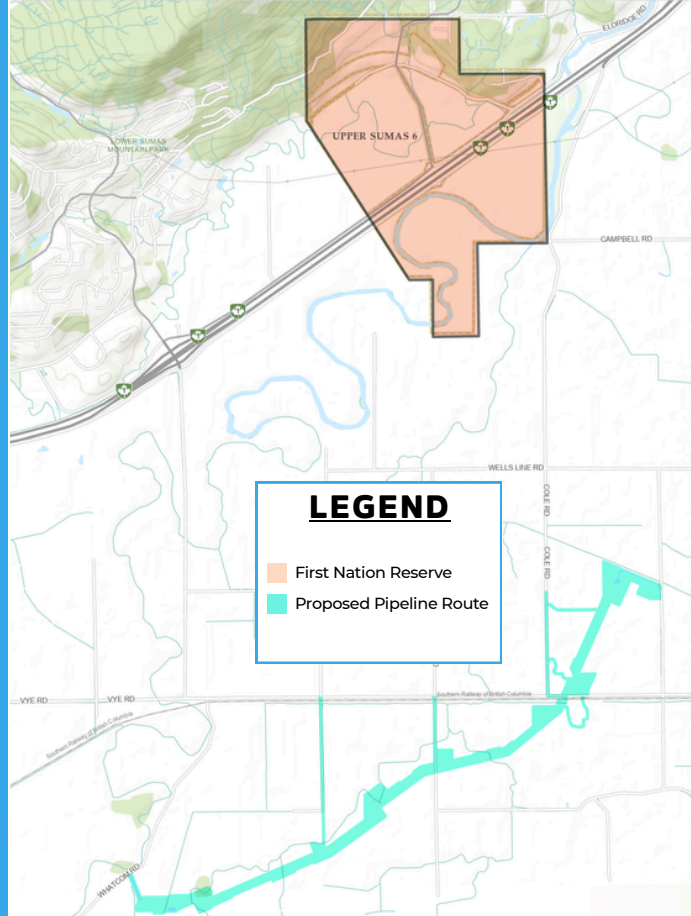
About the Project

Westcoast Energy Inc., owns and operates a natural gas transmission system in British Columbia. The Sunrise Expansion Program (Project) is proposing the installation of approximately 137 km of 42-inch pipeline, looping in various segments along the current system.

The proposed pipeline loops would be added along Westcoast's existing right-of-way and additional loop segments would run parallel and connect to the existing pipeline system.

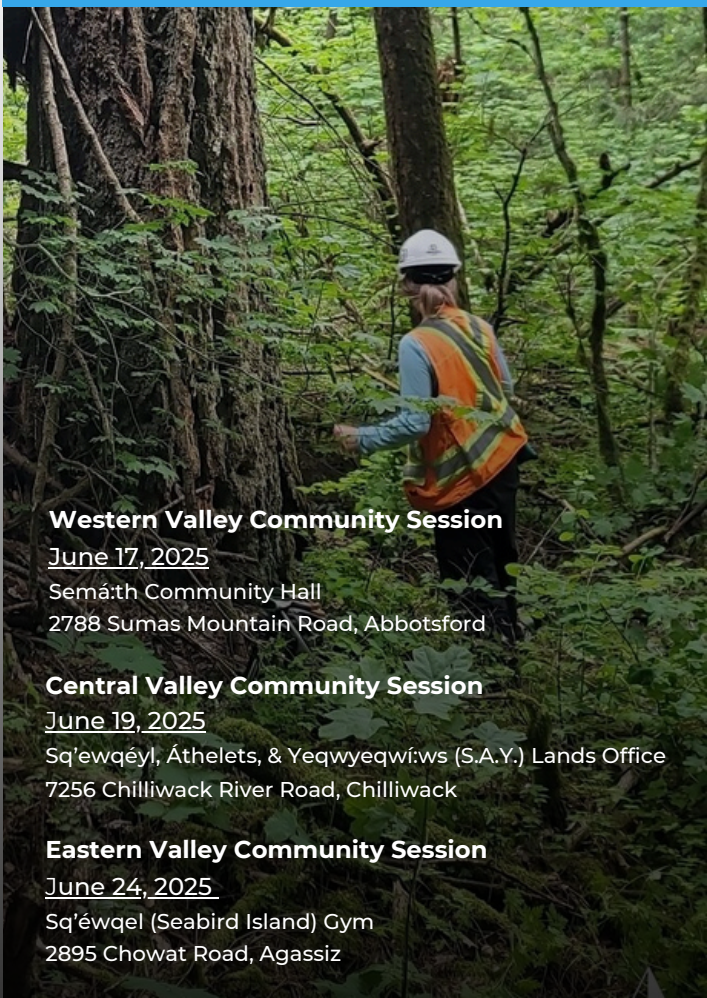

Compressors and Infrastructure Upgrades



Westcoast is planning several infrastructure enhancements to support increased natural gas capacity and reduce environmental impact. In an effort to lower emissions, electric-driven compressor units are being considered. To support electric compression, new overhead powerlines may be required.

The proposed pipeline loops and powerlines would largely follow existing roads or rights-of-way.

Westcoast plans to install new compressors at existing compressor stations such as **Othello (CS-8B)**. Additional modifications / upgrades are proposed for **CS-9 Compressor Station** and **MS-16 Meter Station**.

Pipeline Looping



Othello Compressor Station (CS - 8B)

Within S'ólh Téméxw, the proposed expansion work will involve adding pipeline loops:

- CS-8B to CS-9 (northeast of Seabird Island to south of Cheam): **12.9 km**
- CS-9 to MS-16 Huntington Pipeline (southeast of Abbotsford to Huntingdon meter station, located at the Huntingdon-Sumas border): **4.0 km**
