If you encounter a mountain lion:

- Walk in pairs or groups.
- Don't Run.
- Hold on to your kids.
 - Face the lion.
- Maintain eye contact.
 - Be large & shout.
 - Back away slowly.



Don't ever try to run away, a cougar can...

propel itself up to speeds of 35 miles per hour and jump as high as 18 feet from a sitting position.
